RESOLUTION NO. 22-18

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE NORTH TOOELE FIRE PROTECTION
SERVICE DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Erda City Council ("*Council*") met in regular session on April 7, 2022, to consider, among other things, adopting a resolution supporting the North Tooele Fire District; and

WHEREAS, the North Tooele Fire District does business as the North Toole County Fire District ("*District*") and was established as a special service district in the State of Utah on October 6, 1987 to provide fire protection, emergency medical, and emergency protection services; and

WHEREAS, the District covers a 1,700 square-mile area and services a population of approximately 16,500 people; and

WHEREAS, the District serves the City of Erda; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to express its intent to continue to be a member of the District and continue to receive fire protection, emergency medical, and emergency protection services from the District; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds it in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of City residents and the City as an entity to send a resolution in support of the District and affirm its participation in the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Council supports the District and hereby affirm its intent to be a member of the District and continue to receive fire protection, emergency medical, and emergency protection services from the District and directs staff to send a copy of this Resolution to the District and each member of the Board of Trustees

This Resolution assigned No. 22-18, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
